

## Directions

### Getting to the hostel

Train: Station München-Hauptbahnhof DB (Munich-Centralstation). Exit at Arnulfstraße, take the Tram (connection to Romanplatz) or Tram 17 (connection to Amalienburg), 5 stations and exit at Marsstraße.

You need a single ticket ("Kurzstrecke (K)", €1.20), make sure to stamp it inside the street car. You can buy it at any of the blue MVV vending machines (e.g. right at the street car stop, or inside the train station). Make sure to have some coins ready. If you don't have small change, buy a "Breze" at any of the bakeries (~0.55 cent), it is delicious Bavarian food :)

Plane: Take the S-Bahn S1 or S8 to station Hackerbrücke. Right into Grasserstrasse and the first crossing left into Arnulfstrasse.

You need the most expensive ticket - Zone 4, €9.20. The blue vending machines are inside the airport and right in front of the S-Bahn entrance. You can pay by coins or €10 bill, the vending machine won't accept anything larger.

### Getting to Nokia's office

Tram, U-bahn: Tram (Line 17 dir. Effnerplatz) and exit at "Sendlinger Tor". Switch to the U-Bahn, Line U6 direction Froettmaning or Garching and exit at Nordfriedhof. Walk the about 400m to the office. (Zone 1 ticket)

### Getting to Hilton Munich Park

Tram: Station Marsstraße (tram 17, dir. Effnerplatz), get out of the tram at Tivolistraße. Follow the signs.
